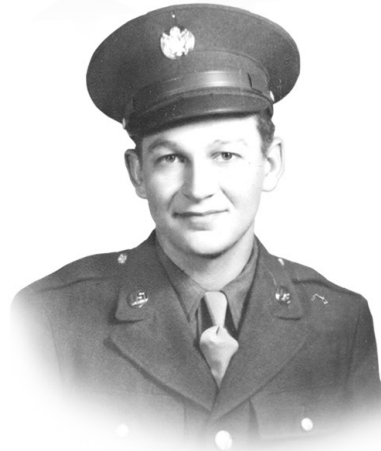

# Georgia State Patrol Post 19

Founded in 1937, the Georgia State Patrol is a division of the Department of Public Safety and is part of Troop F. The Swainsboro Post is one of the original posts and was known as Post 9. Today Post 19 continues the tradition of protecting Emanuel County along with Jefferson, Johnson and Treutlen Counties.

SFC Richard Fishel became post commander in November of 2020

and is assisted by SGT Larry Perkins (retired on November 1, 2021), CPL Robert Scott, and Post Secretary Sara Ferrell. Filling out the roster are TFC3 Gerald Lyles, TFC3 Jim Claxton, TFC1 Payton Riner, TFC1 Stan McCoy, TFC Chris Mcnear and KP Bentley.

During the current year January 1 to October 31, Post 19 troopers have responded to 320 motor vehicle crashes, 111 in

Emanuel County; 10 Fatalities, seven in Emanuel; DUI arrests 158, 66 in Emanuel. Regarding the 10 fatalities, three were alcohol/drug related with two still pending; and eight were no seat-belt used.

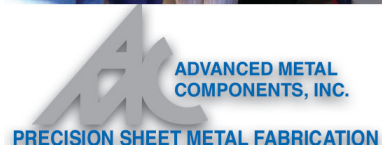

## Emanuel Medical Center

Emanuel Medical Center serves the residents of Emanuel County and surrounding areas. ## Animal Control Officers

Betty Gambrell Animal Shelter Animal Control Officers respond to calls throughout the county and transport the involved canine(s) to the shelter so that proper home placement protocols can begin.

The shelter also responds to assist with dogs at large who show possible threats to civilians.

Intakes within the county as a whole tend to range in high numbers when counting pickups

and drop-offs at the local shelter, which is why shelter staff coordinate with many rescue groups to ensure proper home placement with caring families is prominent in their goal of being a no-kill shelter.

## Georgia Forestry Commission

The mission of Emanuel County Unit of Georgia Forestry Commission is to respond to and prevent wild land fires. The unit also assists timber owners with firebreaks and timber management. Last year, the unit responded to 375 total calls and provided service to 35 landowners, totaling to 1,465 acres. A total of

2634 acres were safely burned using prescribed burns.

The commission dedicated 380 hours on fire breaks, totaling to 769 miles. A total of 3,223 permits were issued to landowners to safely burn approximately 20,000 acres. The Emanuel unit participated in 9 community outreach programs,

many times with Smokey Bear.

Personnel in Emanuel County are Chief Ranger, Charles D. Claxton; Rangers, Brandon Beasley and Doug Claxton; Forester, Jack Foskey; and supplemental employee, Spencer Wood. Remember, as Smokey says, "Only You Can Prevent Wildland Fires."

## Summertown Fire Department
