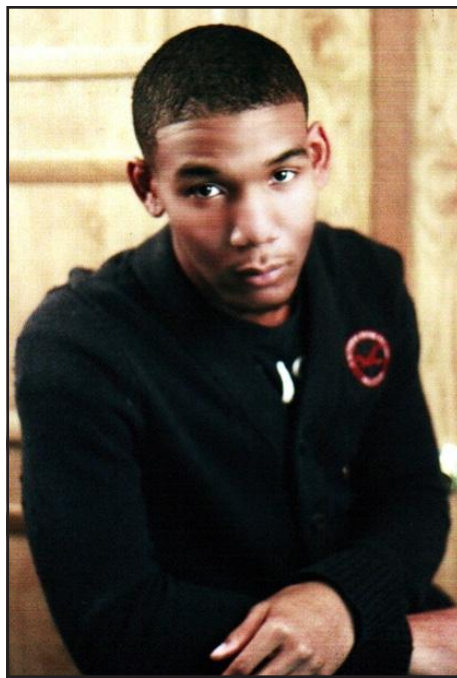

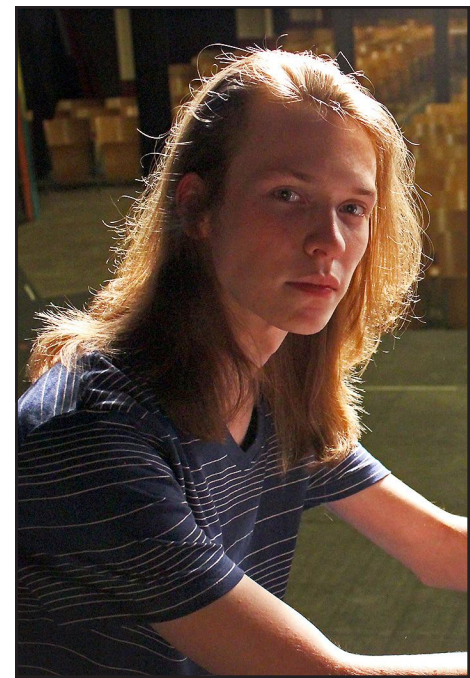
Brian Montel Broadus

Keonna Sheliah Bush

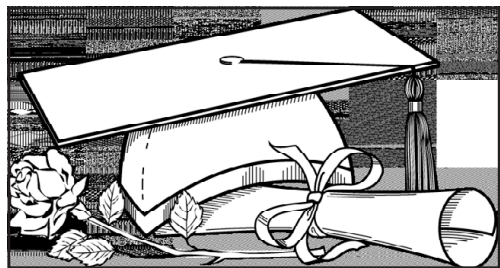

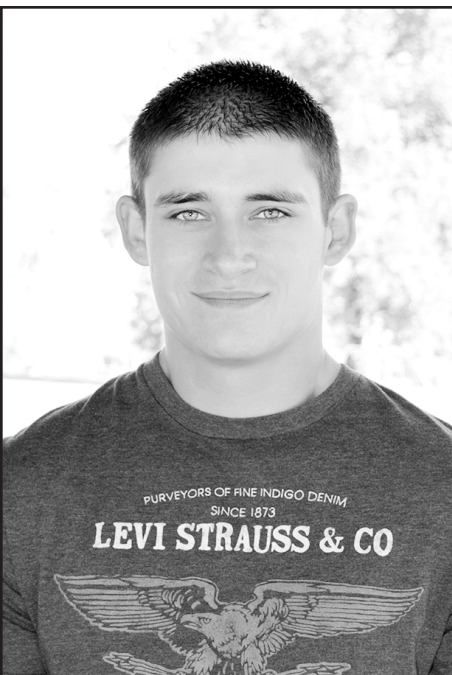

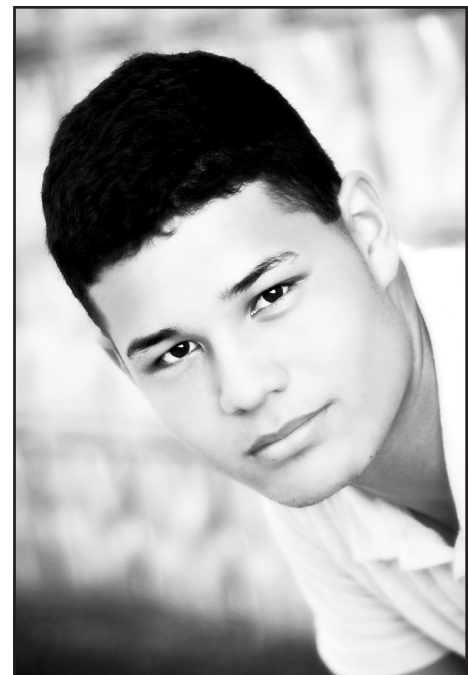
Ryan Quinton Dempster



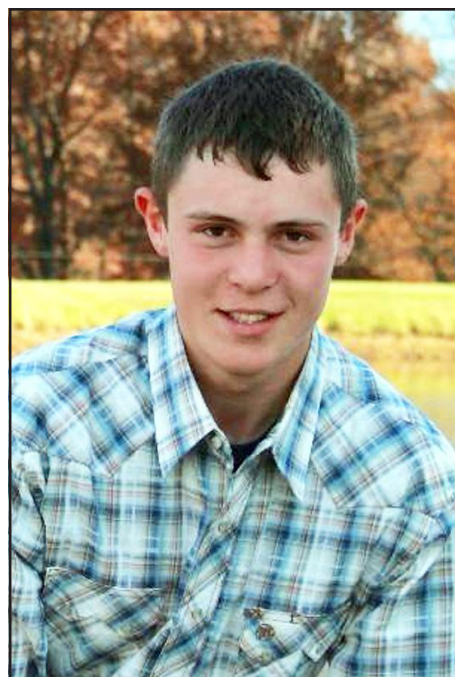
Rahsaan Jessie Marwin Eubanks

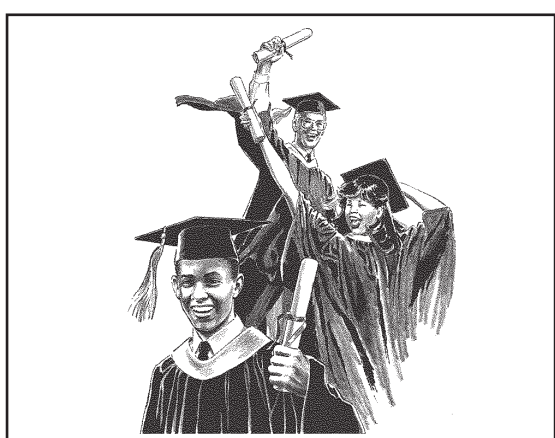
Austin Richard Fuhlage

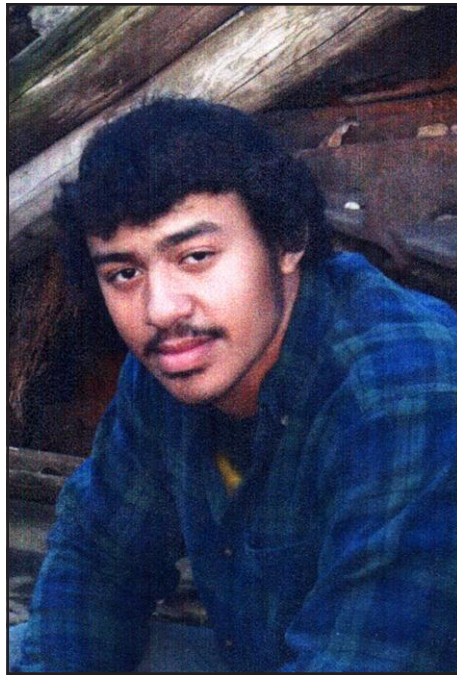

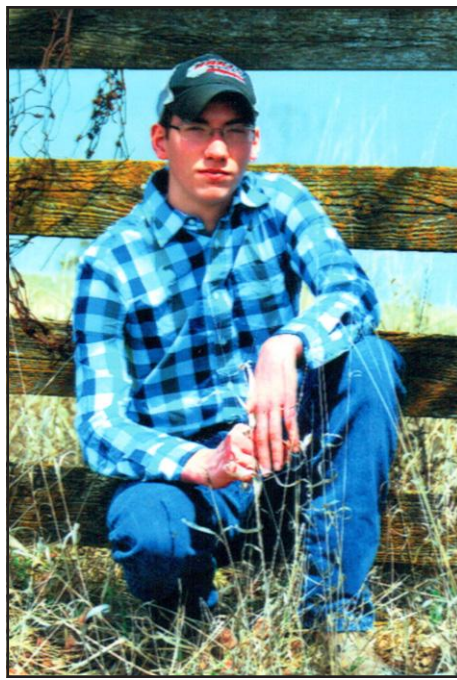

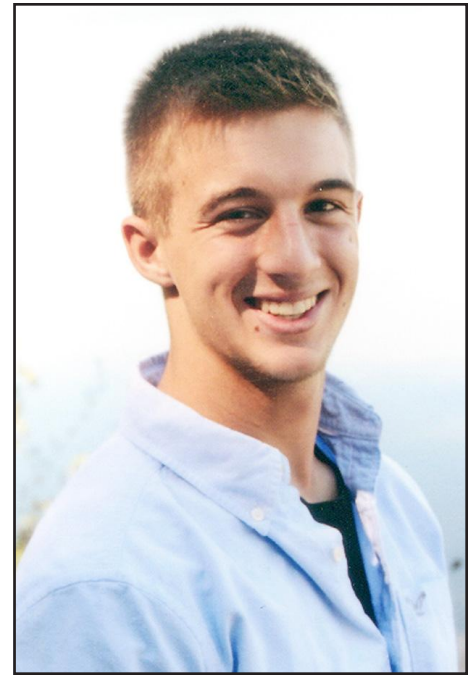
Kyreon Leshae Lee

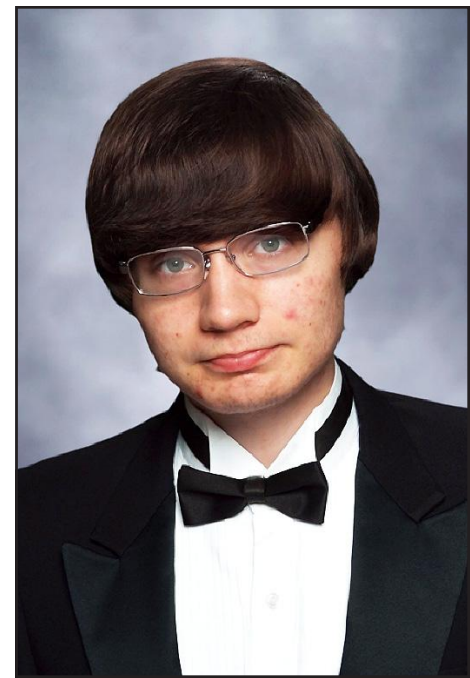
Robert Shawn Miner

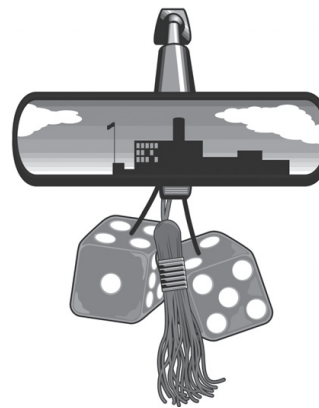

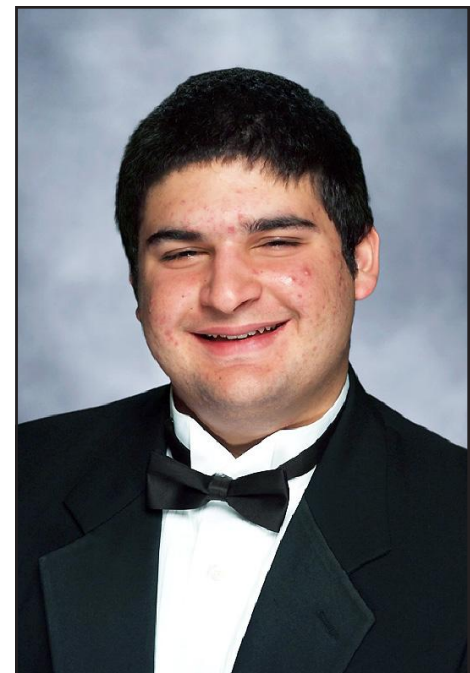
Kaylynn Ratchelle Sims
