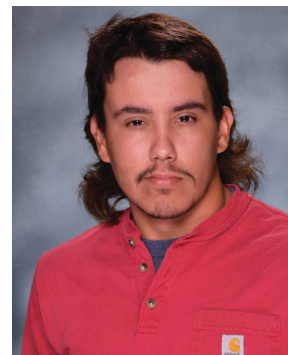

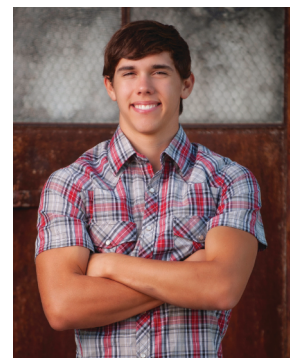

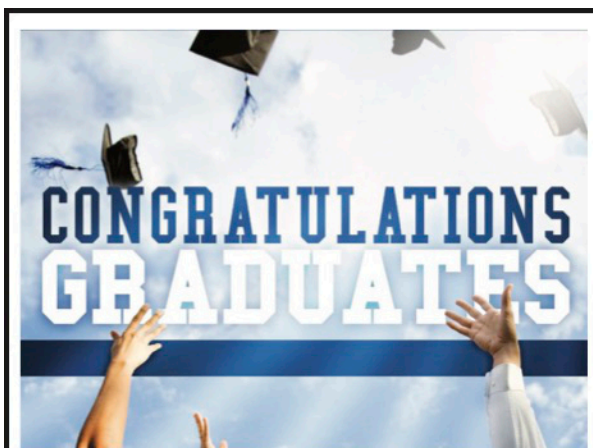
### **Sarah Sims**

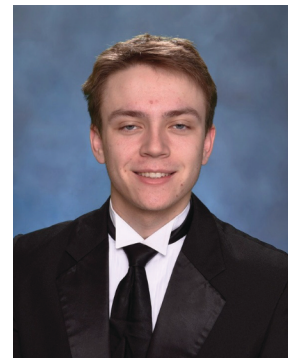

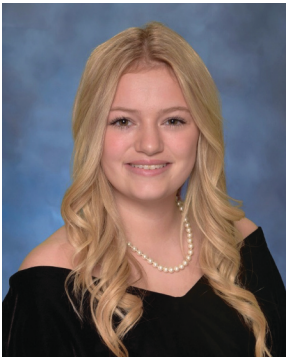

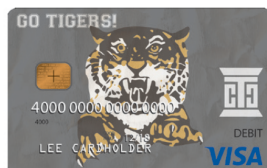
