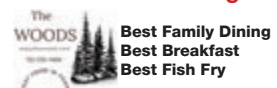



Water Skiing Hours

Waupaca Chain O' Lakes, Spencer Lake & Stratton Lake
Mon. & Fri. (except Holidays) 10:00am-4:00pm
Tues., Wed. & Thurs. (except Holidays) 10:00am-7:00pm
Sat., Sun. & Holidays – 10:00am-2:30pm

Bear Lake: Daily – 11am-Sunset
Wolf River: Daily – Sunrise-Sunset

“Slow No Wake”

There is a “slow no wake” speed limit in effect on the following lakes on the Waupaca Chain O' Lakes: Dake, Minor, Sunset, Long Cove (a portion of Long Lake), Taylor, Otter, George, Bass, Nessling, McCrossen, Limekiln, Ottman, Beasley and the entire Upper Chain. State law also provides for a “slow no wake” limit in effect from ½ hour after sunset until sunrise on all lakes. Spencer Lake and Stratton Lake speed limits are “slow no wake”, except during ski hours. Portions of the Wolf River are “slow no wake” and marked with buoys.



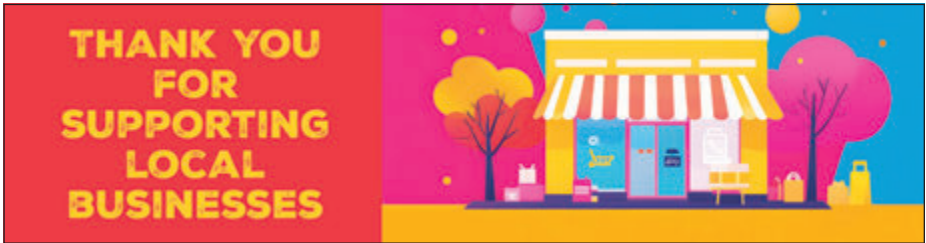

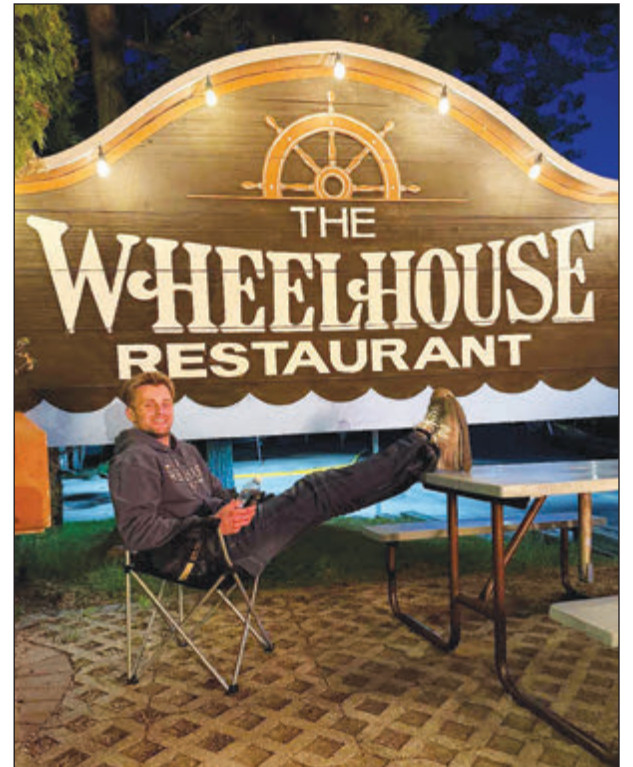
