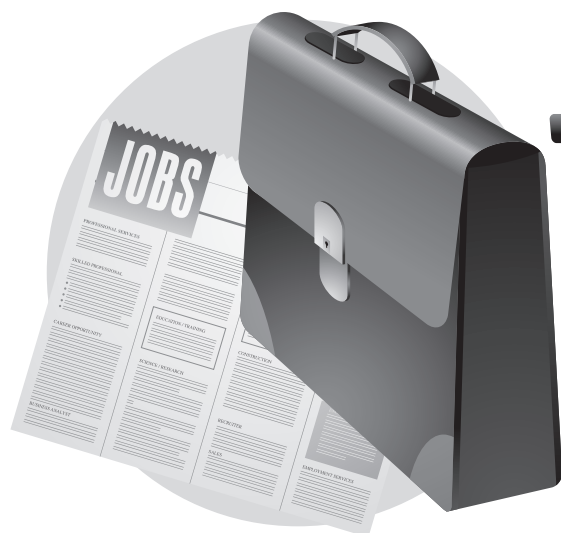

Each Wednesday, barring a ca-
tastrophe, the city of Monticello is
accepting recyclable items at the
Transfer Station within the following
guidelines: 1) Cardboard—must be
flattened. Not accepted are cereal
boxes, drink can boxes or egg car-
tons; 2) Plastic bottles—lids must
be removed and the bottles must
be bagged. Only No. 1 and No. 2
bottles are accepted (the number is
located on the bottom of the bottle).
No wide-mouthed bottles can be ac-
cepted; 3) Newspapers—bagged or
boxed; 4) Aluminum cans—must be
bagged. No tin cans or pet food cans
can be accepted; and 5) Shredded
office paper—must be bagged. To
have recycled items picked up, con-
tact City Hall at 870-367-4400. Note:
Electronics (E-Waste) are accepted
at the city transfer station, 1466 Old
Warren Road, but are not eligible for
pick up. The city reminds all citizens
to not mix household trash with re-
cyclable items. The city does not
accept glass or any item not listed
above at this time.

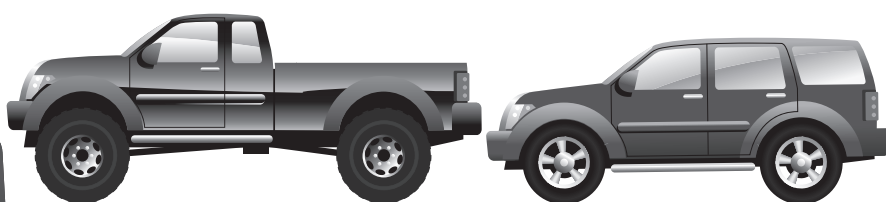

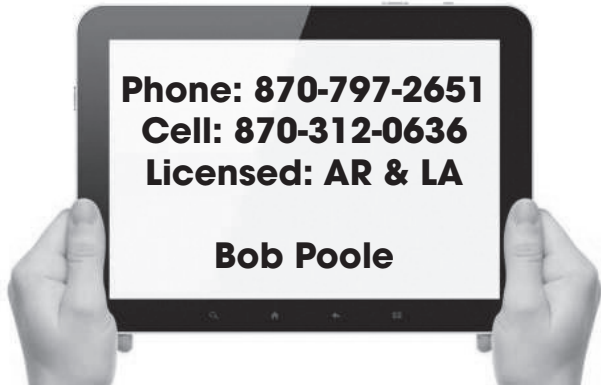
