

Agricultural: If, as of January 1 of the tax year, you own a tract of real property used "to raise, harvest or store crops; raise, breed or man-age livestock; or to produce plants, trees, fowl or animals useful to man," you may qualify for a "special assessment" that will reduce your property tax liability. There are no residency requirements. If you feel you qualify, please contact the Colleton County Assessor's Office. Application period is January 1 of each tax year to January 15 of the following tax year.

MULTIPLE LOT DISCOUNT

A. If you are the developer of a Subdivision having ten (10) or more unsold lots, you may be eligible for a discount on the values of unsold lots. You must apply at the Colleton County Assessor's Office between January 1 to May 1 of tax year.
