West of I-95, Colleton County is more rural, with thousands of undisturbed acres of land. Our flagship publication, The Press and Standard, is published each Thursday and delivered to 4,000 subscribers by the United States Postal Service. Our total market coverage newspaper, The Rockin' Shopper, is carrier-delivered each Monday to 10,500 homes and businesses in Colleton County. These products, in combination with our website — walterborolive.com — deliver news and advertising to over 35,000 readers each week.

Construction is officially underway on LowCo's "Oyster Outpost," a state-of-the-art seafood processing and cross-dock facility in Green Pond, where LowCo. hopes to open its doors to other seafood producers and buyers to draw interest from wholesalers and trucking lines by the end of 2024. "We are so proud of what we've accomplished over the past seven years in just 16 acres of water here in the ACE Basin," states McMillan. "Our goal from the start has always been to feed as many people as possible on the smallest footprint possible, and this expansion will allow us to reach more oyster lovers than ever before in the Southeast and beyond. As we invest in ourselves with this exciting expansion, we're also proud to be able to invest in others. We expect to create more than 30 new jobs in rural Colleton County over the next five years. Giving back to the community has always been important to us as a company, so we are excited about bringing economic opportunity to this area."

This facility will have a state-of-the-art chilled water wet storage system and climate-controlled processing and holding areas – boasting over 10,000 square feet of refrigerated space – making it the first of its kind in the state. The new machines will allow LowCo. to increase production tenfold. McMillan's story is one of perseverance – he does not take no for an answer. As a Charleston native raised on the water, he likes to say that his company started with a boat and a dream. McMillan is now living that dream.





TUSKEGEE AIRMEN MONUMENT

The Walterboro Airport is the Site of the Tuskegee Airmen Memorial. Located on the right as you drive toward the terminal the memorial, rededicated in 2023, is a lasting tribute to the courage and service of the Airmen the served and trained at the Army Airfield in Walterboro.

The Tuskegee Airmen were a group of African American military pilots and airmen who fought in World War II. They formed The 332nd Fighter Group and the 447th Bombardment Group of the United States Air Force. The Tuskegee Airmen received praise for their excellent combat record earned while protecting white American bombers from enemy fighters. The group was awarded the Distinguished Unit Citations.

When the pilots of the 332nd Fighter Group painted the tails of their P-47s red, the nickname "Red Tails" was coined. The red markings that distinguished the Tuskegee Airmen included red bands on the noses of P-51s as well as a red tail assembly. The P-51B, C and D Mustangs flew with similar color schemes, with red propeller spinners, yellow wing bands and all-red tail surfaces.





DOWNTOWN WALTERBORO

Downtown Walterboro is a great place to relax and explore a traditional downtown. The six-block area is home to numerous antique shops, restaurants, boutique clothing stores, a jewelry store, and a classic soda fountain. Washington Street is filled with history, from the 1822 Courthouse and old post office, to the areas that were used in the 2013 film "Radio", the street with recognizable landmarks. The downtown area is on the National Register of Historic Places. The street features oyster shell sidewalks, live oak, and Waterfall Memorial Park that serves as a tribute to fallen Colleton County Veterans. Downtown Walterboro has something for everyone to visit.





COLLETON CIVIC CENTER

The Colleton Civic Center/Hampton St. Auditorium, formally Hampton St. Elementary, has been a historical part of downtown Walterboro for decades. The building, now owned by Colleton County, is home to businesses, artists, and studios who rent space in the classroom portion of the building. Our 480-seat auditorium is utilized for rentals as well as traveling shows, concerts, and other premier entertainment opportunities. As Colleton's premier venue for arts and entertainment, an art gallery is also available for art exhibits as well as meetings and classes. 
The course abounds in the natural beauty of Lowcountry living, meaning a bad day of golf is better than a good day at work and any time is tee-time.

WALTERBORO WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

The City of Walterboro rededicated the George B. Hartzog, Jr. trail in the Walterboro Wildlife Sanctuary Wednesday, July 31, 2024.

The trails namesake, George B. Hartzog, Jr., was born in Colleton County to humble beginnings marked by poverty. After only one semester at college Hartzog left to assist his family, but he did not let the lack of formal education stand in his way. He studied law independently and was admitted to the bar in 1942. After his military service in World War I, he ultimately became the 7th Director of the U.S. National Park Service from 1964-1973. Mayor Young in his dedication speech was proud to have the trail named for an accomplished son of Colleton County. The inaugural dedication of the George B. Hartzog, Jr. trail took place in October of 2013. The original boardwalks and bridges were constructed from wood which degraded over time. Severe weather such as the tornadoes that came through Walterboro also contributed to the damage. The new boardwalks are made of Permatrack, a durable maintenance free prefabricated system. Also, in an effort to ensure the boardwalk is and remains structurally sound, the City opted to use Fuller Piling. The Fuller Pile system is a hybrid pile design that outperforms traditional piling designs to better withstand the elements. The system was invented by Andrew Fuller and is manufactured right here in Colleton County.



SC ARTISANS CENTER

Handmade treasures from selected artists always delight at South Carolina's official folk art retail center.

You could hunt all over the state for authentic handcrafted art representing South Carolina's rich and diverse cultural heritage.

Or you could pop over to the South Carolina Artisans Center, to explore the handcrafted art by handpicked artists; See, Touch, Smell, Taste, and Shop Art.

Located in Walterboro just minutes from I-95, the state's official folk art and craft center is a one-stop showcase for fine handmade crafts of every imaginable variety and media, from Gullah sweetgrass baskets to Southern face jugs, a craft tradition started in Edgefield by african slaves who worked on plantations as potters.

Along with the indigenous folk art created using centuries-old craft techniques, the collection also includes contemporary crafts, large installation sculptures and two-dimensional art.

Fittingly, the nonprofit gallery is housed in a restored eight-room Victorian cottage built in the late 1800s in Walterboro's historic district. Inside you'll find pottery, paintings, jewelry, quilts, mobiles, vases, and furnishings.

The art collection features the work of more than 200 South Carolina master artisans selected in a two-stage

juried process that includes an evaluation by independent professional jurors. Diversity not only represents the population of South Carolina but the offerings at the Center.

Despite the high quality of the wares, you can find Art at every price point.

To be sure, there are plenty of pricier items that have been among the collection, including a \$3,500 sweetgrass basket made by a well-known Gullah artist using a unique coiling technique handed down from her West African ancestors.

One of the most impressive and expensive items in the center is a \$58,000 one-of-a-kind wooden canoe handcrafted by a local artist who lives just outside town. As much works of art as functional boats, these canoes are made from exotic and indigenous woods, fetching as much as \$160,000 for a commissioned tandem.

As its mission, the South Carolina Artisans Center showcases and markets handcrafted artwork of the state's leading artists, while ensuring that art inspired by tradition is protected and nurtured; a gallery that speaks to the unique talents of handpicked South Carolina artists.



IN HIS NAME-COLLETON


In His Name-Colleton exists so that people experiencing homelessness have the resources and guidance to experience spiritual, physical and mental healing and live in sustainable, stable housing.

In His Name-Colleton provides community outreach resources and supportive services, not an emergency homeless shelter. Our office is located at 214 Wichman Street in downtown Walterboro. Our hours are Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 9 am to 12 pm.

January through July 2024, we were able to assist 356 clients, 62 being homeless. We served 3,615 meals to the hungry and gave out 2,500 pounds of food from our emergency food pantry. Our impact from January to July has us on track to double our impact from 2023. In addition to provide meals to the hungry, we have an emergency food and hygiene pantry to anyone in need. Our homeless services also include showers and laundry, assistance with vital documentation and job readiness skills, and transportation for relocation to safe shelter, direct street outreach including meal delivery and free laundry day once a month.

In addition to our community outreach we have a transitional housing program for men and women. We also operate In His Name Community Thrift Store to support our mission at In His Name-Colleton, provide jobs for our transitional housing clients, and provide clothing and household items for those transitioning.

We are excited for what God has in store for In His Name-Colleton and our community! We strive to meet our clients and guests where they are so we can better understand their needs to help navigate through what may be an uncertain time in their life. NAACP #5507

Founded in 1909, the NAACP is the nation's oldest civil rights organization. Throughout the 1920s and 1930s, the association led the black civil rights struggle in fighting injustices such as the denial of voting rights, racial violence, discrimination in employment, and segregated public facilities. Dedicated to the goal of an integrated society, the national leadership has always been interracial, although the membership has remained predominantly African American. The national office of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People was established in New York City in 1910.

The NAACP aimed to ensure for all people those rights guaranteed in the 13th, 14th, and 15th Amendments to the United

States Constitution. The Amendments promised an end to slavery, provide equal protection of the law, and the right for all men to vote, respectively. Accordingly, the NAACP's mission is to ensure the political, educational, equality of minority group citizens of States and eliminate racial prejudice. The NAACP works to eliminate the barriers of racial discrimination through the democratic processes. From the first evolution of the Niagara Movement, Jim Crow Laws, the Springfield Race riots, the right to vote, Brown vs the Board of Education, the March on Washington, the Civil Rights movement, and more the NAACP has championed an integrated society where all are created and treated equal.


