Join the Battle: Fighting Veteran Suicide at the Annual '22 for the 22 Ceremony' Event

Phoenix, AZ – April 12, 2024 – The 22 for the 22 Ceremony Event returns, and it's more important than ever. This annual event shines a light on the pressing issue of Veteran suicide while supporting programs that provide crucial assistance to Veterans and their families.

The first 22 for 22 Event occurred in 2014. It was created to honor those whose lives have been affected by Veteran suicide. It provided a way to remember those who were lost and an opportunity for Veterans, their families, and friends to share their stories. At its inception, the event was named to commemorate how there were 22 Veterans lost to suicide every day. To honor those lost, 22 Veterans would march in their honor.

According to the Department of Veterans Affairs 2022 National Veteran Suicide Prevention Annual Report, the average number of Veteran suicides per day is alarmingly high, rising from 16.4 in 2001 to 16.8 in 2020, with the highest numbers of 18.6 per day in 2018.
